Riverview Park and Zoo Shelter & Event Rules

Approval of events and use of Park and Zoo facilities are subject to the following criteria and rules:

- Reservations are restricted to residents of the City of Peterborough and are booked on a first-come, first served basis. Reservations for a given year open on November 1 of the year prior.
- Maximum 1 booking per year per person or group.
- Solicitation or fund raising is not normally permitted at the Park and Zoo unless approved by the Manager & Curator, Riverview Park and Zoo.
- Due to parking limitations, groups or events anticipating greater than 100 visitors to Riverview Park and Zoo will not normally be approved.
- Picnic area gates and washrooms will not open prior to 8:30 am, and will be closed and locked approximately 30 minutes prior to dusk.
- All visitors must leave the Park and Zoo before dusk.
- Vehicle access to the shelters is only for loading and unloading. Vehicles are not permitted to remain in the shelter or disc golf or disc golf areas. Loading access to Shelter #3 must be requested at the time of booking.
- Activities at Shelter #3 are not to interfere with the disc golf course. Please be considerate of and courteous to golfers.
- No pets or other animals (with the exception of working service dogs) are to be brought onto Park and Zoo property.
- For those groups with reserved picnic shelters, any waste or recyclable materials in excess of what the 2 containers provided will hold, must be disposed of off Park and Zoo property by the visiting group.
- No signs permitted to be posted over top of park and zoo signs. Any posted signs must be removed and disposed of at the end of the event.
- Gas BBQ's are allowed only at the picnic shelter areas. Charcoal/wood barbeques are not permitted.
- Tents, bouncy castles, rides, etc. are not permitted.
- Alcohol is not permitted at Riverview Park and Zoo.
- No motorized vehicles are permitted except on roadways designated as public motorway.
- Prior approval must be obtained for vehicles or trailers larger than 2 metres in length.
- Balloons and straws are not to be brought into the zoo area for the protection of zoo animals.
- A Group Event Liability Waiver form and a Facilities Booking Contract form must be completed and returned to the Park and Zoo no later than one week prior to the event date.
